The Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) Support Officer works with vulnerable victims and witnesses of Anti Social Behaviour and provides support to perpetrators who may be vulnerable due to their circumstances such as age, substance misuse, mental health and/or from a minority group or community. This may involve developing preventative interventions to address the problem for example develop Community Agreements or Behaviour Promises.

What is my Aim?

- To offer advice and support to vulnerable Perpetrators of Anti Social Behaviour who maybe under threat of losing their tenancy.
- To try and stop ASB using alternatives methods, other than costly enforcement.

What can I Do?

- I provide information, advice and support in the form of regular support visits to the home to try to identify underlying issues that maybe the cause of ASB and refer to other agencies that could offer additional help and support.
- I can put in place a behaviour promise for young people if I feel this could help change their behaviour.
- I offer relocation support visits to vulnerable perpetrators who have been re housed due to Anti Social Behaviour.

What is a Community Agreement?

A Community Agreement is a contract developed by the residents of an area. The agreement identifies issues affecting the community and how the residents can contribute to help tackle these problems.

We do not have a set time scale for involvement, each case will be assessed on an individual basis. Support is not permanent and will be reduced over a period of time, as my aim is to support the perpetrator to modify their behaviour and maintain a successful tenancy. However if intervention is unsuccessful and my involvement proves not to be effective in tackling issues, I will refer the case back to the housing provider / ASB Team for enforcement action.

The definition of vulnerable can have several meanings so please contact me if you are in any doubt whether a case is suitable for referral.
